The reviewing process is aimed at providing constructive comments.

About the book/module

1. The manuscript in question should include:

Author(s)/Editor(s)names; Title (tentative); Estimated length (in number of words and pages); Number of tables; Number of figures and/or plates; Other special features.

2. Outline of the book/module

We would like you to focus on the following aspects related to the outline of your book: What type of book is it (e.g., research monograph, collection of articles, reference work, text book); What is your motivation and particular qualifications to write/edit the work; If your book is based on a Ph.D.thesis, explain how you have revised this into a research monograph; Please send a copy of the table of contents and a concise description of the volume; Please indicate the intended readership of your book.

3. Possible reviewers of your manuscript

Please list up to three professionals in your field (with their addresses) who are qualified to objectively read and evaluate your manuscript. Please provide names, addresses, fax numbers and/or e-mail addresses.
